Remember moulded studs are obligatory for PTFC.

Laws of the Game – you should all be aware there are two "governing" bodies the FA and WFA and their laws and interpretations differ (why is life so difficult!). For the avoidance of any doubt, unless specifically advised, all our training and games will be played under FA laws. The two most important laws are –

- NO non-walking and this is likely to extend to any perceived fast pace.
- NO contact whatsoever. Therefore no tackling from behind or the side.

There is also a growing view that excessively hard shooting should be considered dangerous play and penalised with an indirect free kick to the opposition. Statistically low controlled shots are more likely to chalk up a goal.

Training fees – will continue at £5 per session for the time being. Committee is reviewing two aspects –

- Whether it is viable to switch to a monthly standing order that would not specifically relate to sessions offered/played
- Whether it is viable to introduce card payment via SPOND.
